
Communication Services Available at Briercrest

Important information for students to stay in contact with friends and family







Internet

A wireless internet connection is available for all students and guests on campus. The signal's name (also called an SSID) is **Briercrest Internet**. There is no password or encryption on the system. There is no fee and any device is free to connect to it.

The maximum connection speed possible is 3mbps upload and download for each device. The internet bandwidth is shared equally among all users, so connection speeds may decrease during peak usage.

The **Briercrest Internet** wi-fi connection is available in all school buildings, including the academic building, dorms, the rink, gym and The Point.

If students have questions, concerns, or need help with the Wireless Internet System they should contact the Information Systems Department (see "Quick Contact Information").

*Please Note: Use of this service in the Caronport High School dorms requires that the student install accountability software on their personal computer. Students should contact their dorm leadership for more information.

Personal High Speed: College and Seminary students can sign up for personal Internet services in their dorm rooms through SaskTel. Please contact SaskTel for current rates and terms of service information.

Phone

For cell phone service, SaskTel, Telus, Bell, and their affiliates all work well in Caronport. Reception from other providers (such as Rogers/Fido) is limited.

If students wish to have their own personal phone line installed in dorm they can contact SaskTel at: 1.800.SASKTEL (1.800.727.5835). In order to register for SaskTel services, they require a credit card, Photo ID, P.O. Box and their dormitory's street address (see "Dormitory Street Addresses").

Fax and Printing Services


Faxes can be sent and received through the Archibald Library or the Briercrest Bookstore for a flat fee of \$2 per fax (see "Quick

Dormitory Street Addresses: In order to setup a personal telephone or Internet service through SaskTel, students will need to know the physical street address of their dormitory. These addresses are listed here:



Mail and Parcels

Students who wish to receive personal mail or parcels are encouraged to go to the Caronport Post Office (located at the corner of Centre Street and 2nd Avenue) and set up a post office box. The boxes are free and students only need one piece of government issued photo ID to register for the service. Students can provide the post office box number to friends or family who wish to contact them by regular mail or to send parcels via Canada Post. Student mail should not be sent to the address of Briercrest College and Seminary. Mail addressed to a student's PO Box should be addressed as follows:

If a student needs to have a parcel sent to them via Purolator or UPS, the Student Development office will accept these parcels on behalf of the student. Collect-On-Delivery (COD) shipments will not be accepted. When a parcel arrives for a student, a pickup slip will be placed in the student's academic box and the student can come to the Student Development office to retrieve their parcel. Students are required to present their student ID card and sign for receipt of the parcel. Ideally, parcels should be sent via Canada Post to the student's own PO Box. About Student ID Cards

Each student will receive a student identification card that identifies him or her with the school in which they are enrolled (Briercrest College, Briercrest Seminary, or Caronport High School).

These cards are issued each September and give the student access to Library resources, meals and food in the Cafeteria, The Point, and Crossroads Coffee shop, as well as act as a general student photo ID.

Students should take extra care to protect their cards. If a student loses or damages their original card a replacement ID can be requested through Briercrest Live. A \$20 fee will be charged for a replacement ID card.
