



## Saskatchewan Advantage Scholarship

### ACADEMIC SERVICES

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The Saskatchewan Advantage Scholarship provides every Saskatchewan grade 12 graduate who completes grade 12 in 2012 or later, and enrolls at a Saskatchewan post-secondary institution, up to \$500 per year to a lifetime maximum of \$2,000 over 10 years. The scholarship will reduce tuition for eligible post-secondary education and training programs starting April 1, 2012.

Students beginning studies on or after August 1, 2012 will not need to apply for the Saskatchewan Advantage Scholarship as your post-secondary institution will apply on your behalf. **Filling out this form will provide your consent to Briercrest College and Seminary to apply for the scholarship on your behalf.** Eligible students will have their tuition reduced by the scholarship amount and the Government of Saskatchewan will reimburse your Saskatchewan post-secondary educational institution directly. The scholarship amount will be deducted from your first semester payment.
